About Sri A.Sivaramakrishnan ...

Sri A. Sivaramakrishnan was born on 14-04-1931 at Trichy to Sri Anantha Narayanan and Alamelu Ammal. After school education, he did his B.Sc(Maths) in National College, Trichy. He joined B.Ed in Spicer college, Pune and studied about all religions in same college. He worked as a professor in Spicer college, Pune for few years. After that he joined as a Head Master in Seventh Day Adventist School, Kudiyaatham, Villupuram District. His mother Smt. Alamelu Ammal started a home for orphan children in Kanyakumari in the year of 1952.

In 1965, during the period of Prime Minister Mr. Lal Bhadur Shastri and President Mr. RadhaKrishnan, Sri A. Sivaramakrishnan was the only person selected by the government for the six month training program for child welfare at America. In 1969, he did his M.Ed(Maths) at Thoothukudi VOC College. In 1970, Sri A. Sivaramakrishnan took the responsibility of SKGA after the death of his mother Smt. Alamelu Ammal.



About SKGA...

SKGA stands for Sri Kanyakumari Gurukula Ashram. It is a non-profit, charitable, tax exempt society. SKGA was founded by Smt. V. Alamelu Ammal at Kanyakumari on August 25, 1952. She was guided by her Guru H.H. Sankaracharya, Sri Nithyananda Giri Maharaj, Sri C. Sitharam from Sri Aurobindo Ashram and Sri A. L. Kalidas associated themselves in the early years and developed the ashram. Through their untiring efforts, the ashram was able to care for most needy poor children. Leading members of Kanyakumari and Thirunelveli districts supported the work. Besides Government grants, donations are needed.



Services...

SKGA admits children who have lost either one or both parents, and are most poor, destitute, helpless or neglected, and need love, care, maintenance and education.

SKGA conducts home for boys and girls and offers them total care free of cost for many years. It helps them to enjoy their childhood and begin a new way of in a cottage, peace, joy, health, happiness and hope, and regain their dignity, self-respect, self-image and self-confidence. At SKGA, a unique feature of the free, residential care, maintenance and education is that the children are cared for till they complete high school or higher education and leave. Some of them stay on till they complete an arts or professional course and are habilitated. The uniqueness of children recognized. Personal care and parent-like love mark adult child relationships.



Campuses...

ALAMELUPURAM (1971):

The administrative office was started at Alamelupuram. All the administrative work is taking place in this office. The office is now well established with good infrastructure and well qualified staff. The office is provided with 3 computers to manage all the works. The storage system is provided to store the important documents. At the age group of 10 - 18 years boys are staying in a cottage situated at Alamelupuram. The cottage is provided with well equipped room to store the groceries and other food material.

SITHARAMAPURAM (1975):

It is located in Thirunelveli to Kanyakumari route. The area provides good environment to children. SKGA was started with single cottage which is now well developed with 5 cottages, in which 150 children can accommodate. Beautiful guest house also built here to meet of the requirements of the guests who visit and help organisation. Girls are provided good atmosphere, well protected and safety atmosphere.

NEW LAND (1980):

SKGA having a place at tourist place kanyakumari. This place is called as new land providing good environment for children. In the campus has two buildings. One is a Cottage for Children. The other is a building where sick children's can be accommodated when needed. The New land campus is blessed by the location of the 'Memorial' spot to the Mother on this campus.

Other Programmes...

ALAMELU MATRICULATION HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL:

The school started with nursery and primary sections. The school was upgraded into higher secondary level with medium of instruction in English. It's recognised by the government of Tamilnadu. The Ashram students are given good education at free of cost.

Not only the Ashram children, the poor children from neighbouring villages are getting good education at lower cost. Transport facility also provided for them. The school is furnished with well modernised science lab, Library, Smart classes, Playground and sports materials.

Many children well placed in top position and they are well settled in their family life also. Most of the children are engineers, Nurses, Doctors. They are providing their life by showing humanity to others.



An English-medium higher Secondary school is also located in the campus of Sitharamapuram run by sister charity.

Dairy and agriculture activities are also conducted.

Day care creches are also conducted in two villages.
